

Using the right materials, anyone can install a great fountain water feature! All you really need is an aesthetic eye, the willingness to get a good physical work out, and keeping with the tried and true products and methods we provide.

With a minimum of garden tools you will be well on your way:

- Work gloves
- Wheelbarrow
- Pick
- Shovel
- Level
- Cedar wedges (aid in leveling and manipulating fountains).

Everything else is provided to you with your stone fountain.



Select the area for your pond. Allow extra room for water splashing off the fountain.



Dig the hole 12 to 18 inches deep so ample water will circulate to the pump.



Deepen an area to accommodate the five gallon bucket which will later hold the pump.



Lay felt material into the hole, tamping it down so that there are no gaps between it and the soil below.



Follow with the rubber liner. Considerable material is required to completely line the hole.



Position belting to separate the cement blocks from the rubber liner below.



Place blocks onto the belting. Stack blocks if necessary to bring the fountain's base just below water level.



Position fountain(s) onto the blocks. Consider the effect you want to achieve.



While positioning your fountain(s), find a route for the plumbing to reach the bucket's lid and the pump.



Partially fill the pond for testing. Using the ball valve, adjust the flow of water coming off the fountain(s). Fill the pond with decorative rock.



Trim away the excess liner and felt materials. Spread the rocks out to completely cover the liner.



Allow your fountain to run for a couple of days so sediments can fall and the water can clear.
